Jointly funded by the Australian Government (\$10 million), NSW Government (\$29 million) and the Bega Valley Shire Council (\$5 million), the Eden Breakwater Extension project is now large enough to accommodate cruise ships larger than 300 metres in length.

The Breakwater Wharf project is managed by the Department of Primary Industries – Lands. The project is overseen by a cross-agency project control group committed to delivering an infrastructure solution to meet the needs of the cruise sector and maximise the economic opportunities for the region.

The project control group is working closely with Bega Valley Shire Council., Destination NSW, Cruise Eden, Carnival Australia, Sapphire Coast Tourism and others to ensure the project is a success.
